India Future Foundation Work during Covid-19 Lockdown



- ❖ 2000 dry ration kits delivered to the workers stranded in Gurugram and nearby areas (1 ration kit serves a family of 5)
- ❖ More than 2500 cooked meals delivered to the underprivileged
- ❖ 500 PPE(Personal Protection Equipment) kits delivered to hospitals for medical personnel
- ❖ 100 hand sanitizers provided to frontline workers
- ❖ Created awareness about the best practices to fight Covid-19 such as social distancing and managing personal hygiene



How India Future Foundation came forward to respond during crisis

- ❖ Crowd funding Dry ration and ensuring distribution to workers
- ❖ Working on Community Kitchen essential supplies and distribution of cooked meals.
- ❖ Distributing Hand Gloves, Sanitizers and Face Mask
- ❖ Keeping tab of Social Media for fake news, anti-sangh activities
- ❖ Best practices to fight Covid-19 such as social distancing and managing personal hygiene
- ❖ Distributing PPE kits to Doctors treating patients in Gurugram (Medanta)and Delhi (Max Hospitals)

- ❖ IFF has set an emergency response team of volunteers, who are identifying places where government administration or other not for profit organizations are not able to reach.
- ❖ The volunteers are supplying dry ration and cooked meals to workers in Delhi/NCR.



Command post

- ❖ It all started with a small center setup by Mr. Kanishk Gaur (Co-founder, IFF) in his backyard in Gurgaon to help workers in the nearby areas.
- ❖ The aim of this center was to provide the following:
 1. Dry ration
 2. Cooked meals
 3. Hygiene kits (Masks & sanitizers)
- ❖ Based on availability and need, one or more of the above mentioned items gets delivered.
- ❖ This small center now operates as a command post. It controls and coordinates with 4 warehouses & 2 community kitchens across Gurgaon. It now manages to deliver the required items in Gurgaon, South Delhi, Central Delhi and a few areas in NCR as well.

Stock Management & Personnel

- ❖ Four warehouses are used to collect and maintain the supplies.
 - ✓ Sector 90 New Gurgaon : maintained by Mr. Ashish Nigam
 - ✓ Sector 57 Gurgaon : maintained by Mr. Kanishk Gaur
 - ✓ Sector 39 Gurgaon: maintained by Mr. Ishwar Singh
 - ✓ Sector 51 Gurgaon: maintained by Ms. Bhawna Gupta

- ❖ Distribution of supplies is handled by the following volunteers :
 - ✓ Vikas Kumar
 - ✓ Hitesh Agarwala and
 - ✓ Anoop

- ❖ Two community kitchens are also setup in Gurgaon with the help of vendors to serve home cooked food.





Relief Intelligence gathering

- ❖ A dedicated team of volunteers gathers information to identify distressed population clusters and floating population clusters for delivery of relief material.
- ❖ This information is gathered with the help of Police authorities and is then sent to the Command post.
- ❖ There is a cross verification team which checks if there is duplication of relief by other NGO or by administration.
- ❖ This ensures targeted delivery and avoids duplication of relief.



Transport & Delivery

- ❖ Permissions and passes are obtained for all the volunteers and the vehicles for food distribution
- ❖ There are 6 cars and 2 two wheelers for delivering the food packets
- ❖ There is coordination with the administration, local police authorities and other NGOs to deliver these supplies.
- ❖ Continuous tracking and monitoring of the relief material is done via Whatsapp groups from the command post.
- ❖ Each Vehicle is commanded by Police personnel to ensure tracking and delivery of relief material while maintaining Safe Distancing norms by affected population ad safety of volunteers.
